How to vote in the NTI Election for Vice President

NTI wants to remind all members of the Nunavut Agreement that there is an election for Vice President on December 12, 2022. All Inuit who are 16 years of age on December 12, 2022 can vote in the upcoming election.

Individuals can vote in their community on Advance Polls on December 5th from 10 am to 7 pm, or on Election Day on December 12th from 10 am to 7 pm. There will also be mobile polls available in every community in Nunavut from December 6-9th. If you are not able to go to a polling station on December 5th or 12th and require a mobile poll, please contact your local CLO.

If you are out of your home community during the election period you can vote by proxy for Vice President. You and a consenting member of the NA must both fill and sign a Proxy Application and a Consent to Act as Proxy, it must then be brought to a polling station. Fax and scanned copies are accepted but there must be a hard copy left at the polling station. A voter may vote as a proxy no more than three times during this election period.

There will also be four polling stations set up in Ottawa, Edmonton, Winnipeg and Yellowknife, where members will be able to vote for NTI Vice President. These polling stations will be open for Advance Polls on December 5th, from 10 am to 7 pm and Election Day, from 10 am to 7 pm.
